Other information:

Your child will need the following things. Please <u>PUT YOUR CHILD'S NAME</u> <u>ON ALL ITEMS</u> – i.e. back pack, gym runners, footwear, jackets, etc. in permanent felt pen.

- Gym strip runners only please, no black soles; please choose shoes that your child can fasten by themselves. These can double as inside shoes (no laces please)
- 2. One back pack or bag for carrying things (keep in mind when purchasing, it should be big enough to hold a large library book zippers are better than ties).
- 3. In September, please send **\$65.00** to pay Kindergarten fees. **\$35.00** is for school supplies, **\$20.00** covers Cultural Performances, and planners, while **\$10.00** covers the Kindergarten cooking and nutrition program. We have an e-transfer option for payment.
